

## **Reading Recreation Commission Summer Internship - PAID**

The award-winning Reading Recreation Commission is seeking a highly motivated, creative and energetic Marketing, Public Relations, Business, or Parks and Recreation student to complete an internship with the Reading Recreation Commission. The Reading Recreation Commission is a community partnership between the City of Reading and Reading School District, funded in part by tax dollars, that provides quality programs and facilities to the residents of Reading. We provide neighborhood-based recreation and learning opportunities for all ages - with an emphasis on affordable programs for children - at schools, parks, playgrounds, and at our two recreation centers.

Intern will be involved in all aspects of the Recreation Department. This position will run from late May/early June through mid-August (11 to 13 weeks). The intern will complete on average 40 hours/week working weekday's from 8:00am to 4:30pm. Interns may be asked to work special events that fall after 4:30pm or on weekends.

Primary responsibilities will include developing a branding toolkit for the Reading Recreation Commission to include all marketing materials, social media management, and website updating along with assisting with summer programming and rentals. Other aspects of the internship will include learning the day to day operations of the Recreation Department including: recreation programming, summer camp, special events, swimming events, & sports programming.
