# **Summer 2025 Coed Volleyball Rules**

- 1. Match Location:
  - Matches are held on Thursday evenings at:
    - 3rd and Spruce: 320 S 3rd St, Reading, PA 19604
- 2. Match Start Times:

#### 3rd and Spruce:

- First match: 6:30 PM (Arrive by 6:00 PM to help set up)
- Second match: Approximately 8:00 PM (be in the gym by 7:45 PM)
- 3. **Playing Conditions**: All matches are played indoors with climate control.
- 4. Match Structure: Every match will consist of four sets to 25 starting at 4-4. Sets will be capped at 27
- 5. **Point System**: Teams earn 1 point for each set win.
- 6. **Net Rules**: High school net rules will be strictly enforced:
  - A net fault occurs when a player touches any part of the net, antenna or extension with any part of the body, except for hair. Reaching under the net to catch a ball that has not completely crossed a centerline or placing hand at net to direct a better ball will be considered a net fault.
  - Any player whose foot/feet or hand/hands is completely on the opponent's side of centerline will be called centerline violation. Any body part or entire hand or foot on the floor is a violation. Body parts over the centerline but not on court are OK if there is no interference with opponent.
- 7. **Scoring Guidelines**: Scoring follows USA Volleyball guidelines: only one toss is allowed 8 seconds to serve rally scoring.
- 8. **Team Composition**: Each team consists of 3 male and 3 female players (alternated). If a ball is contacted more than one time before being returned; at least (1) contact must be a female. Remember a touch on a block is not the first contact, therefore anyone may play the first touch over immediately with no violation
- 9. **Player Absences**: If a player is missing, the 'ghost' position gives up the serve. The vacant position will be determined by the opponent and referee.
- 10. **Arrival Time**: Teams scheduled for the first matches must arrive 30 minutes early to set up nets. Matches must start promptly.
- 11. **Teardown Duties**: Teams playing the last matches are responsible for teardown and cleanup after their matches. The second match will start immediately following the first match.
- 12. **Minimum Players**: A minimum of 5 players is required to start a match.
- 13. **Insufficient Players**: Insufficient players will result in losing the first set after 10 minutes, the second set after 15 minutes, and the entire match after 30 minutes.
- 14. Forfeit Responsibilities: Forfeiting teams are responsible for both referee fees. \*If a team knows a potential forfeit and can give Chelsie O'Neil a two-day notice, they may not be responsible for full fee.

### \*Money MUST be turned in prior to your next match\*

- 15. Referee Fees: Referee fees are \$20.00 per team. NO electronic payments
- 16. Line Duties: More players should assist with line duties.
- 17. **Roster Additions**: Players can be added to rosters until June 12<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
- 18. **Playoff Qualification**: Players must participate in at least 4 matches to qualify for the playoffs. The Reading Recreation Commission pays for fees for semifinal and final matches. T-shirts for champions.
- 19. When there's no rule, the referee's rules are final.
- 20. Theres no pursuit at either site
- 21. A rule update: Players are only allowed to play for ONE team during the season. If any illegal players are found on a team, the result will be a forfeit for each set, and the team will play under the "ghost rule," as outlined in the rules sent out before the season started.
